Terms and Conditions

Programs Cancellation Policy

When a person wishes to cancel their enrolment in a Community Engagement program, they may be eligible for a refund, as detailed below.

- 1. If more than one week's notice of cancellation is provided, the participant is eligible to receive a full refund or credit.
- 2. If less than a week's notice of cancellation is provided, the participant will not be eligible to receive a refund or credit other than for exceptional circumstances which must be detailed in writing to the City. Examples include, but are not limited to, illness and family emergencies.
- 3. A participant may, at any time, cancel their enrolment in a program and nominate a substitute participant to attend in their place (provided the substitute participant meets any / all other program registration requirements).

Tour Length, Terrain and Safety

- Participants must bring their own water and water bottle
- Participants must arrive 15 minutes before their allocated tour time
- Tours start at Wilkinson Homestead
- Each tour takes around 1.5 hours to complete
- Participants that arrive late will not be permitted to join the tour once it has commenced
- Parts of the trail are through parkland, rough surfaces, uneven ground and gravel.
- People with heart complications are not recommended to take the tour
- Over 200 people are buried at Kenwick Pioneer Cemetery. Because many of the headstones no longer exist, we ask that participants follow their leaders' instructions and stick to the marked paths
- This event is strictly for children over the age of 10 years
- Prams/strollers are not permitted
- Animals are not permitted
- This event will be photographed. Please notify your leader if you do not want your photograph taken
- The trail does not have full wheelchair access
- Torches must be turned off when approaching ghostly actors. Do not shine your torch at the actor
- This is an alcohol-free smoke-free event
- Refunds are subject to the City of Gosnells refund policy
