



**POLICY NO. CP 2.1.7**

**POLICY STATEMENT      SPORTS LIGHTING ON ACTIVE RESERVES**

**PURPOSE**                      To establish Council's position on sports lighting for active reserves.

**POLICY**

1. Sports lighting on active reserves will be provided to a training standard in accordance with Australian Standard AS-2560.
2. Where a sports club seeks an upgrade in sports lighting from a training to competition standard, the Club will generally be required to fund the upgrade costs. (A part of this cost may be able to be offset by grant funding).
3. The City may provide lighting to a competition standard, or a financial contribution to such a standard, where:
  - Multiple sports use the reserve; and/or
  - Council considers there to be a broader community benefit in doing so.
4. The City will generally seek external funding to offset costs associated with either the provision of sports lights or the upgrade of sports lights from a training to a competition standard.
5. Changes to Australian Standards or State Sporting Association guidelines do not commit the City to upgrade sports lighting to the new standard before programmed renewal.
6. The City will manage and maintain all sports lighting on its public active reserves.
