



STREET SWEEPING

City-controlled roads and City-owned car parks are swept on a regular basis to keep the streets clean and safe for road users and reducing blockages in the drainage network.

The City carries out street sweeping according to a planned schedule throughout the year, as well as responding to reports of any hazards. The City's current service levels are to sweep the streets up to 6 times per year.

Sweeping operations are conducted throughout the City between 6am and 2:30pm in residential streets, in accordance with the City's noise management plan for these operations.

Early starts are occasionally required in high traffic volume areas and ensure community safety by having sweepers off the road during afternoon traffic peaks. This minimises congestion, delays and upholds the City's service levels.

The City performs sweeping on all roads with the exception of Albany Highway, Kenwick Link, Tonkin Highway and Roe Highway.

Requests for additional street sweeping should be limited to the following:

- Foreign matter on the road represents an unacceptable hazard to users (e.g. broken glass, excessive sand or dirt).
- Excessive rubbish on the road is interfering with or is likely to interfere with the flow of storm water.

Council officers will assess each of these requests and determine whether or not the additional sweep is warranted. The City will not carry out additional street sweeping simply because of leaf litter. To report a hazard please contact the City on 9397 3000.
