Get ready to be 'shook all night long' with some of the biggest hits from Australian rock legends AC/DC and Cold Chisel at the free City of Gosnells Rock Revue concert.

Coming up on **Saturday 29 March** from 5pm to 9pm at Centennial Park Amphitheatre in Gosnells, the concert will feature tributes to Cold Chisel performed by Rising Sun, with the Australian AC/DC Experience performing AC/DC's biggest hits.

Rock Revue follows hot on the heels of the City's successful Rock Opera concert held last month at Centennial Pioneer Park, pictured right, which had the crowd captivated.

Concertgoers can pack their own picnic, or purchase food from a variety of food trucks. Rock Revue is an all ages event, however a licensed 18+ bar area will also be available at the event. Photo ID will be required to enter the licensed area and there is strictly no BYO.

Ticket registrations are essential and available from **Friday 7 March**, with a maximum of four tickets per person.
