Youth Week in the City of Gosnells


Young people aged between 10 and 18 can join a jam-packed program of free activities and events hosted by the City of Gosnells during WA Youth Week.

Held on Friday 11 April, Tuesday 15 April and Wednesday 16 April at various locations across the City, free events and activities include cupcake decorating, birds of prey display, craft activities, dodge ball, basketball and an evening of live music and pizza.

The 2025 Youth Week WA theme, 'Our Threads, This Place, Your Moment', centres on young people's connection to community, each other and themselves.

Regulars are encouraged to attend events outside their usual youth centre as a way to connect with other like-minded young people who also live locally.

Held each year, Youth Week WA aims to provide opportunities for young people to get together and express ideas, raise important issues and listen to one another in a safe, inclusive space while also celebrating their positive contributions in the community.







Switch to save energy

Switch Your Thinking will deliver a series of in-person and online workshops on a range of energy efficiency topics as part of its Energy Efficiency Pilot Program.

Through the program, Switch is also providing energy audit kits for local library members to check home energy efficiency levels and learn how to reduce power and water bills.

The program is funded by the Western Australian Government's Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety. Switch Your Thinking is a joint initiative of the City of Gosnells, City of Armadale and Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale.

Drop off hazardous waste

Dispose of hazardous waste and unwanted items in a safe, sustainable way at the City of Gosnells Community Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Day on **Saturday 5 April**.

Open to residents in the City of Gosnells, the drive-thru drop-off day will accept household hazardous waste and other items that cannot be disposed of in the regular household rubbish collection. Waste can be dropped off at the City's Operations Centre at 2 Canning Park Avenue in Maddington, between 8am and 3pm on the day.

Proof of local residence must be provided.

If you aren't aware of Snap Send Solve, it is a free app that provides an easy and efficient way for community members to report issues across the City, at any time of the day, including photos and an exact location.

I have used this app countless times to report a range of issues such as graffiti, illegal parking, dumped rubbish, abandoned trolleys and more. The City achieved an overall user rating of 4.25 out of 5 across 2024, which is a fantastic achievement as it shows how proactive our residents are when it comes to reporting issues around our community.
