Health and education should never be out of reach. I will support more bulk-billing clinics, fairer Medicare rebates, and walk-in hubs for GP and mental health services. I will also work with TAFE and training providers to create stronger youth skills programmes, safe spaces, and real job pathways for our young people.

I will also support plant trees in areas that are prone to heat, work with DFES and volunteers to get prepared to deal with floods and bushfires, and restore local habitats. I will advocate for more CCTVs, better lighting, and clear sightlines will also make public places safer. I also want to help community programmes that help people get to know each other.
