The people and organisations who make a significant difference to the City of Gosnells community have been celebrated at the Australia Day Big Breakfast.

Kylie and Joel Burns were joint winners of the Community Citizen of the Year Award, recognising the countless hours they spend selflessly supporting families in need by preparing and distributing food hampers, connecting people to services and providing practical and emotional support.

Youth Citizen of the Year Hania Usman has volunteered for nearly 10 years with the Armadale Gosnells Landcare Group. She also volunteered at the Perth Royal Show waste and recycling stations, for the Push-up Challenge and serves as a marshall at Homestead Parkrun.

This year, two Senior Citizen of the Year Award winners were announced. Rajeshwary Krishnan was recognised for more than 45 years improving the health outcomes of First Nations communities and establishing wraparound care for generations of families. Janice Baker was recognised for her outstanding commitment to the Friends of Mary Carroll Wetland's efforts to improve local biodiversity and engage the community in landcare activities.

The City of Gosnells Walking Groups received the Active Citizenship Award for keeping local seniors active, engaged in their community and improving physical health while nurturing a sense of belonging and social inclusion.
