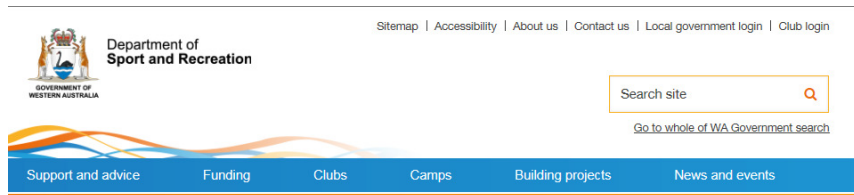

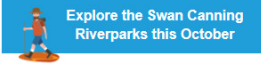

The new Public Health Act requires each local government to provide a local public health plan that applies to local government areas. The legislation provides an opportunity for local governments to highlight the role they play in promoting and enhancing health and wellbeing, education and recreation. To assist the Act the Department of Sport and Recreation (DSR) recently released a template for local government Public Health Plans. The template is available on the DSR website. The workshop will allow you to have an understanding of the legislation and the requirements for local government, development of a public health plan, and the role of sport and recreation.
