Wilkinson Homestead Museum is located on the banks of Canning River and houses a collection of locally significant items which provide an insight into the history of the area.

The Museum relies on the generosity of its volunteers to act as activity leaders in fun educational programs for school groups, to be involved in senior social group outings and to play a role in special projects and events.

## Activity leaders

The Museum offers hands-on activities for primary schools that explore aspects of domestic life in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century.

If you enjoy assisting children with learning and find education endlessly fascinating, then join the Museum's education volunteers as an activity leader. The hands-on activities are easy to learn and never boring.

The program is held on Wednesday mornings during school term and is suitable for school aged children from Kindy to Year 7.

When you start as an activity leader at the Museum you are paired up with an experienced volunteer and gradually build up your skills until you can independently present one activity.

A weekly commitment is preferable for this program.

## Senior social group outings

The Museum offers a history talk and guided wander through the collection, with a cuppa, for senior recreation groups.

Bookings are taken by request so volunteers can be required on any week day.



## Special projects

The Museum's education program is constantly developing and needs people with teaching experience to help with special projects such as those listed below:

- Assist in the development of education materials and resources so that teachers can make use of the Museum education collection.
- Write education material to enable local schools to incorporate community history into their programming.
- Assist in the creation of incursions.

## Special events

The Museum always requires volunteers to assist with special events including open days and heritage walk tours.
